A View from the Terrace

DEAR RESIDENTS OF THE TERRACE

We know that in Canada we have four distinct seasons every year. This year we will have **93** days of spring which started on March 20, **94** days of summer as of June 21, **89** days of autumn that begin on Sept.23 and **89** days of winter which will start on Dec.21 (yes, that does add up to 365 days.) Environment Canada issues these forecasts as they vary slightly from year to year.

But how do we experience those seasons in Grimsby?

We read three weeks ago that the famous spring flower gardens in the Netherlands, the "Keukenhof", were in full bloom, attracting thousands of visitors every year, while we looked outside and saw the snow-plough pushing the 10 cm. of snow that fell during the night, into a big pile. Over the years we have found that our winters seem to be by far the longest season of the year. We also remember that it was not wise to buy our bedding plants too early, as we could still expect frost during the night right up to May 24th. Every year it seems that we have to wait so long for spring to finally arrive here and for the weather to warm up enough so that we can comfortably spend more time outside without having to wear warm winter coats. But there are also some very interesting facts about our weather. This year the spring equinox happened on March 20. As the word implies, that is the day when both the night and the day will be exactly 12 hours long. That will happen again on Sept. 23 when the fall equinox occurs. Did you know that only on those two days will the sun rise exactly on the equator and follow its course straight above the equator all day till it sets in the West? That event is called a solstice and these only happen twice a year. It also is very interesting why we celebrated Easter Sunday on April 21. It was in 325 BC, that the Council of Nicea established that Easter should be celebrated on the first Sunday after the first full moon occurring on or after the spring equinox. But we must always remember that our Lord Himself was completely in charge, He chose that He wanted to die as the Perfect Lamb of God at exactly the time when all the Passover lambs were being sacrificed and that God would raise Him on the third day. We remember Christ's resurrection on the first day of the week and celebrate His victory over death every Sunday. (B.L.)
