During the month of April, we celebrate the greatest expression that *God is Love*. We are overwhelmed by the familiar, inspiring verse of **John 3:16** (NKJV):

¹⁶For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

There is no other way of salvation. Let's look at the following statements that Jesus made about himself:

1) In **John 6:35** (NKJV):

³⁵ And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life..."

As our use of bread satisfies an essential need for survival every day, so our relationship with Jesus needs to be a daily interaction of praise and prayer with our Saviour and Lord.

2) In **John 8:12** (NKJV):

¹² Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

Jesus promises that His Holy Spirit will guide His followers when we feel uncertain about the future.

3) In **John 10:11** (NKJV):

¹¹ "I am the good shepherd."

A good shepherd knows his sheep and they know his voice. Sheep only follow the shepherd whose voice they know.

4) **Matthew 28:20** (NKJV):

²⁰ "... I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age."

5) **John 11:25** (NKJV):

²⁵ Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live."

Note the assurance that we may accept God's promise of eternal life.

6) **John 14:6** (NKJV):

⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

There is only one way to be assured of salvation. The good news of the gospel is available by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone. - B.L.

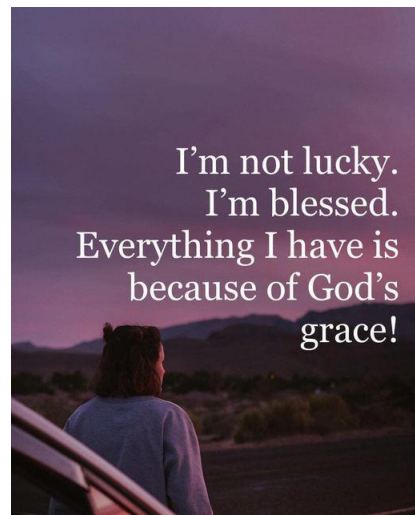
