Note from the Editor:

Meister Eckhart (c.1260 – c.1328) was a German Catholic priest and theologian. He didn't write poetry, but many of his sermons had a poetic quality to them. Working from an English translation of the German text of his sermons, Jon M. Sweeney (author, scholar) and Mark S. Burrows (poet, translator, scholar) reworked select excerpts of those sermons into verse.

This poem was adapted from a sermon Meister Eckhart preached on Isaiah 60:1, and meditates on the downward movement of love that raises us up.

Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you.

TRASH TALK

Although some K-cup coffee pods (for Keurig style coffee makers) are labeled as being recyclable, did you know that they must be dismantled into several parts in order to be recyclable? Specifically, the **lid must be peeled off**, the **coffee grounds** must be deposited into the **composting bin**, and the **plastic cup** must be **rinsed** and then deposited into the **blue bin**. But that's so much work!!

Instead, we suggest that K-cup coffee pods be disposed into the trash. Thanks!

- When bringing compost downstairs, please carry the bag in its container bin, to avoid further unsightly littering and dripping of contents on the carpet or hard flooring in the common hallways. Let's try to keep the wooden and tile floors dry, to avoid slippery, unsafe conditions.
